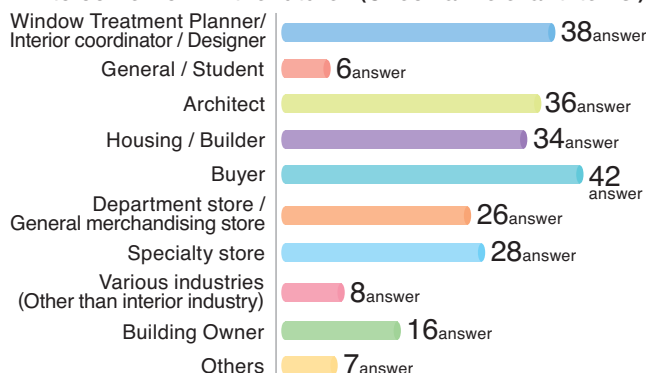

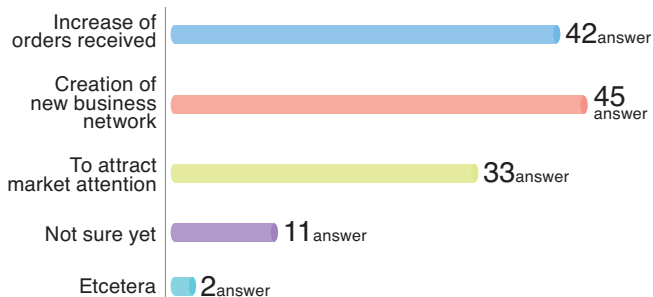

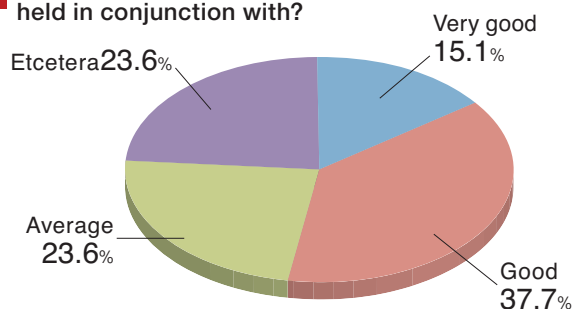

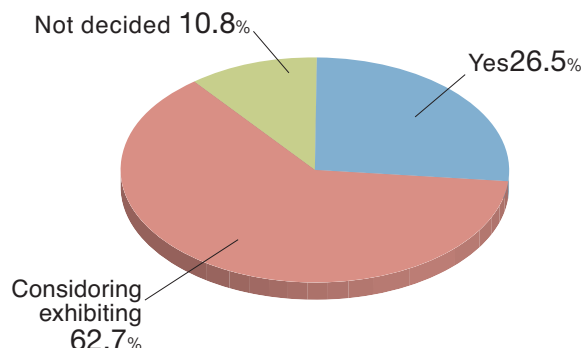

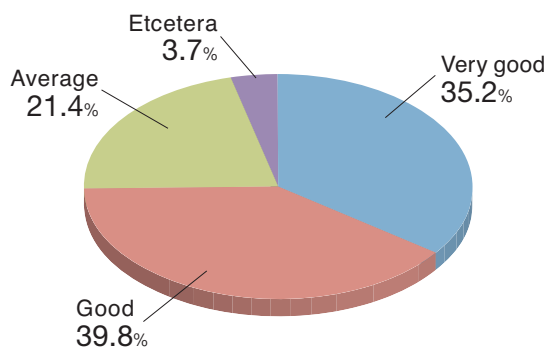

■ Opening Ceremony

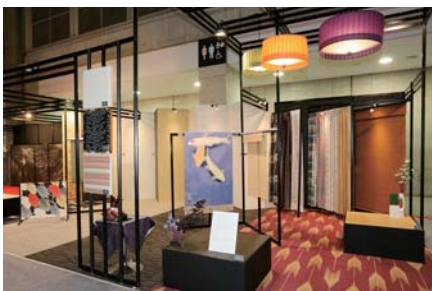
In the presence of Her Imperial Highness, Princess Takamado, and Kosaburo Nishime, State Minister of Economy, Trade and Industry, the opening ceremony got under way, on an especially constructed stage, at 9:00 a.m. on November 15 (Wednesday), 2017. Ichizo Yoshikawa, chairman of the Nippon Interior Fabrics Association, delivered an opening address. This was followed by an address by Masami Nakamura, chairman of the board of the Japan Management Association; a congratulatory address by Parliamentary Vice-minister Takumi Ihara; an explanation of the show by Takeshi Nishida, Chairman of the Executive Committee of JAPANTEX; and remarks by Princess Takamado. The three days of the exhibition were officially initiated by a tape-cutting by Princess Takamado. A joint JH and BS reception began in the reception hall at 17:30 on the same day.



■ Theme exhibition, "Japan Style x Interior Beauty – Japan's Hospitality and Humanistic Design Aesthetics"

◆ "Harmony" of materials, "Harmony" of interiors

This area embodied the themes of JAPANTEX2017, "shitsurai" (preparations for guests) and "the beauty of interior design" in Japanese hospitality. Using as its motif the traditional colors, patterns and designs of "Harmony" that have been refined over generations, curtains, wallpapers, carpets, tatami mats and sliding screens, paper wall hangings and sliding doors were exhibited with the cooperation of the association's member companies and the Tokyo Hyougu Kyouji Naiso Bunka Kyokai.

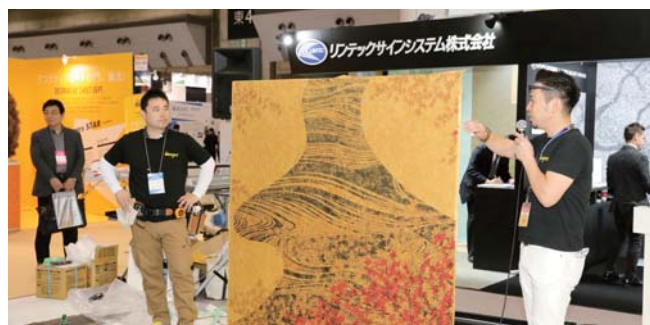
■Nippon Interior Fabrics Association Booths

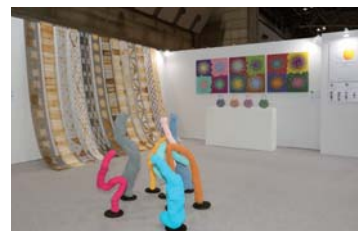

Each of the winning companies received a commemorative plaque and a supplementary prize (a feature article in a special issue of an interior design journal) presented by Executive Vice Chairman Yasujima.
